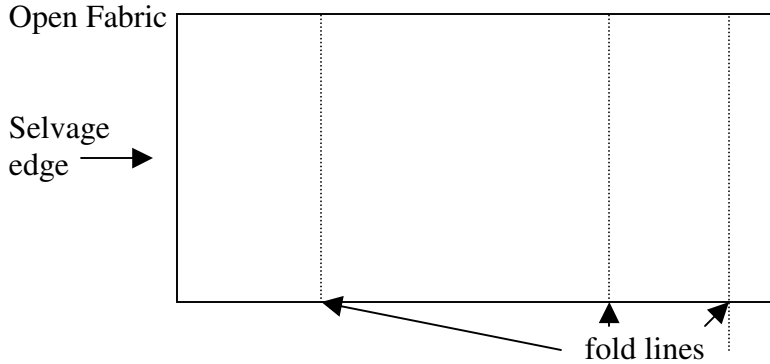


Cabin Fever Quilts & LaRue's Country Quilts

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3 Ring Binder Cover 1"



Items Needed

$\frac{1}{2}$ yard will make full covers with full front and back pockets or
12.5" Fabric for no pockets.
12.5" x 22.5" quilt batt warm and natural or 2 oz. Thin polyester batt.
(Wider binders need 23"-26").

Cut fabric 12.5" wide. Use $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance.

Mark 10" in from selvage edge. Measure 21.5" from last mark and mark. Measure 10" from last mark and fold fabric over. Sew seam to make clean finished edge, or serge to hem.

Fold fabric front sides together and place opening side up onto batting. Layer – baste or pin and sew. Two side seams.

To make back fabric half cover and front pocket you can use the same amount of fabric. Simply cut the back half 5" from selvage and hem. To make front and back full covers with pockets you will need an extra 5" of fabric. You will need to clean finish or serge all 3 edges of pocket for 4" x 9" front & back pockets.
