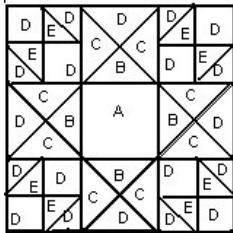




Ohio Star Variations Block 11

Contrary Wife Star #11



12" finished block, 12 1/2" unfinished block.

- Sew scant 1/4" seam allowances, do not open seams.
- Do not stretch bias points if at all possible, this will make it very hard to match points.
- Square up all 9 patches to 4 1/2".

Colors & Size of pieces: Cutting Chart

- A. Green floral, Center: Cut 1 square 4 1/2"
- B. Blue cream floral: Cut 1 square 5 1/4"
- C. Dark Blue Stripe, Points: Cut 2 sqs. 5 1/4"
- D. Cream Solid: Cut one square 5 1/4". and then cut 4 squares 2 7/8", and 8, 2 1/2" squares.
- E. Red floral: Cut 4 squares 2 7/8"



ASSEMBLY

1. Four Point Triangles.

- A. Follow Quick Method for making 4 point triangles.
- B. Use 1 CB (Blue floral & Dk blue) 5 1/4" square to make 1 set, and make 1 CD (Dark Blue and Cream) 5 1/4" square to make 2nd set. Draw lines, sew "X".
- C. Cut apart and sew half of 2 point square using 1 of each color set.

2. Corners:

- A. Follow General Instructions Quick Method 2.
- B. Using fabrics DE 4 squares 2 7/8" draw line & sew.
- C. Make 8 triangle squares.
- D. Cut "+" from 5" block. Making 8 squares 2 1/2" and lay out corner blocks following diagram. Red points all face the center of each corner square forming an angled bow tie on corners.
- E. Line up center seam points and sew 4 patch together. (Pin the heart of each point if desired). Sew seams flip-flop so you can wiggle them together.

3. Lay out all pieces of the block.

- A. Make sure the green floral center aligns with the blue/cream floral side of dark points to face the center.
- B. Solid Cream is on all the outside edges of this block.
- C. Sew rows together as in diagram above.
