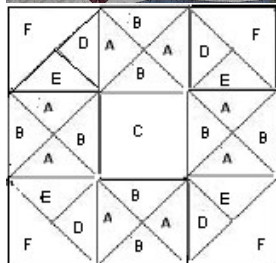




OHIO Star Variations 5

4 Square Garden # 5

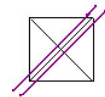
12" finished block, 12 1/2" unfinished block.



- Sew scant 1/4" seam allowances, do not open seams.
- Do not stretch bias points if at all possible, this will make it very hard to match points.
- Wiggle back and forth with seams folded opposite each other to get a perfect set. Pin points together if needed.

Colors & Size of pieces: Cutting Chart

- A. Points - Red w/gold dot: Cut 2 squares 5 1/4"
- B. Solid Cream: Cut 2 squares 5 1/4"



- C. Center Green Floral: 1 square 4 1/2"

- D. Red Solid: 1 square 5 1/4"
- E. Red Floral: 1 square 5 1/4"



- F. Cream squiggles: 2 squares 4 7/8", divided diagonally to make 4 triangles.

ASSEMBLY

1. Point triangle squares: Follow the "Quick method for making 4 triangle points." On Ohio star General Instructions.
 - A. Use 2 large 5 1/4" squares AB, draw diagonal lines, sew and cut.
 - B. Sew AB triangles together to form point squares.
 - C. Sew 2 AB squares to opposite sides of center C.
2. Corners: Sew half DE 5 1/4" squares together as in general instructions.
 - A. Sew F triangles to sewn DE triangles to form 4 corner squares.
3. Sew 2 triangle point squares to center C forming middle row.
4. Sew 2 corner squares DEF to each side of AB triangle point squares to form 2 rows. Watch color placement, follow diagram making sure A and D are sewn together.
5. Sew rows together following diagram.
