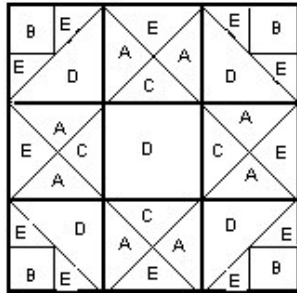




Ohio Star Variations Block 7

Triangle Square Star #7



12" finished block, 12 1/2" unfinished block.

- Sew scant 1/4" seam allowances, do not open seams.
- Do not stretch bias points if at all possible, this will make it very hard to match points.
- Square up all 9 patches to 4 1/2".

Colors & Size of pieces: Cutting Chart

- A. Dark Green: Cut 2 squares 5 1/4".
- B. Medium Green Corners: Cut 4 squares 2 1/2".
- C. Colored Lt. Green Floral: Cut 1 square 5 1/4".
- D. Pale Green/cream Floral: Cut 1 center square 4 1/2" and Cut 2 squares 4 7/8" diagonally.
- E. Solid Cream: Cut 1 square 5 1/4" and 4 squares 2 7/8" diagonally.

ASSEMBLY

- Four Point Triangles.
 - Follow Quick Method for making 4 point triangles.
 - Use 1 each of AE, and AC 5 1/4" square to make 2 sets. Draw lines, sew "X".
 - Cut apart and sew half of 2 point square using 1 of each color set (light/dark and dark/medium).
- Center Row:
 - Sew Green floral side of 2 point squares above to each side of center D (4 1/2")
- Corners:
 - Lay out each corner, using B corners with E solid to form diagonal half of corners.
 - Sew short side of 2 small triangles E to each corner of B squares to form "L". This creates half of corners.
 - Sew these to diagonal pieces of D to form corner squares.
 - Make sure square is in each corner following diagram above.
- Lay out all pieces of the block.
 - Make sure the red chain and light green chain form an "X" down center block
 - Sew rows together as in diagram above.
